


OUR NUMBERS

The mission of Academy Prep is to inspire and empower students qualifying for need-based scholarships to become future community leaders through a rigorous middle school program coupled with ongoing graduate support.

- 155 children participate in the 11th Month Program funded by CAB, allowing low-income students to have a valuable summer experience that may otherwise not be available to them. This includes providing educational and life skills training
- 2,325 healthy
 breakfasts and 2,325 healthy
 lunches were served to
 students during the 11th
 Month Program
- 52.5 hours of academic classwork time was gained by students in the 11th Month Program
- 31 students participated in swim safety classes to prevent accidents related to drowning

CAB'S IMPACT

- 60 children coming from underprivileged backgrounds received a nutritious mid-day meal, regular visits from a pediatrician including immunizations, and a stimulating environment for developing motor skills and emotional wellness
- 0% dropout rate of 421 students, including those receiving CAB support

The mission of Ashraya is to provide noninstitutional solutions for underprivileged children through education and family support.

GOA, INDIA

The mission of The Colvale Migrant School is to keep children off the streets and in school by providing a safe learning environment.

- 30 children were nurtured, taught, and fed nutritious meals
- 50 students from lesser economic backgrounds facing language obstacles were taught and given remediation in their school subjects, taught to read and write the English alphabet, identify and draw shapes, and improved their physical and mental health

CAB'S IMPACT

- 40 girls at the Girl2B Coaching Center (Educational Support Unit) benefited from CAB funding for daily tuition for English, Math, Science, and Bengali - as well as computer, music, yoga, sports programs, counseling, and motivational support
- 90% of the girls became regularly punctual
- 13 girls have improved their speaking and communication skill in English
- 29 girls are regularly washing their hands and learning good hygiene practices

GIRL2B FOUNDATION

NEW YORK, NEW YORK

The mission of Girl2B is to give every young girl a chance to reach her full potential, freeing her from the unfair cycle of poverty, and making her an agent of change through the empowerment of education.

HEMOPHILIA SOCIETY BANGALORE, INDIA

The mission of The Hemophilia Society, a registered organization affiliated with the Hemophilia Federation of India, is to provide educational and medical aid to those who have Hemophilia and are completing their education.

- 18 students with Hemophilia were able to receive schooling, books, supplies, backpacks, shoes, and uniforms thanks to CAB funding
- With CAB donations, students receive healthcare for managing bleeding episodes which enable them to attend school regularly and subsequently excel at school exams
- 80-100 children receive basic medical aid, such as bandages, braces, ankle binders, walkers, crutches, and more.
- Students are trained in skills such as computer software, driving, farming, and entrepreneurship

CAB'S IMPACT

- 94% of at-risk children at the Dorothy Thomas Center have earned the right to participate in the Furry Tales program, which represents the students working hard to be calm, caring, and kind throughout the week; making positive changes to their behaviors
- 15% increase of chapter books in Kids & Canines library, indicating profound reading advancements for students who are years behind in their reading skills. Reading to the dogs every week has enabled and motivated them to practice their reading skills

KIDS & CANINES

TAMPA, FLORIDA

The mission of Kids & Canines is to give at-risk youth the support, tools and opportunities to empower themselves and improve their lives, and; to provide trained dogs to individuals looking for emotional support from a dog, and to those looking for a dog to serve in a therapeutic role.

MATHRUSHREE SCHOOL FOR THE MENTALLY CHALLENGED BANGALORE, INDIA

The mission of Mathrushree is to provide abandoned children and youth with intellectual disabilities with safe residence, proper education, and medical care.

CAB'S IMPACT

- CAB funding enabled a part-time Physiotherapist, Speech Therapist, and Special Educator on premises
- 24 malnourished children between the ages of 18 months-10 years receive nutrient supplements and milk
- 103 children receive necessary medications and regular doctor's visits

CAB'S IMPACT

- 700 students benefited from the CAB-funded iReady Program which provides diagnostics and individualized instruction to each student based on their needs and abilities
- 46% of students reached their growth goal in math + 45% reached their growth goal in reading

The mission of Pepin Academies is to empower students with learning and learning-related disabilities to reach their full potential by providing a high-quality education in a stimulating, low-threat learning environment with a wide variety of services.

RAMAKRISHNA SCHOOL BANGALORE, INDIA

The mission of S. Ramakrishna Memorial Kannada Primary and High School is to provide free education to underprivileged children in rural/semi-urban areas, regardless of background or religion, empowering them to claim equal rights as citizens of India.

CAB'S IMPACT

- 1,118 text books in subjects like math, social science, English for underpriveleged children at the school
- Clean drinking water for school system
- **Up to 15 new teachers** to instruct subjects: Environmental Studies, English, Computer Sciences, Physical Education, Mathematics, Science, and Nursery level

\$26,000 TOTAL TO DATE \$67,500

CAB'S IMPACT

- 40 students rescued from hazardous situations and provided basic needs such as a clean, safe shelter with food
- 5 hot dinners per week for all students in SRN facility, complete with a stocked kitchen and readily accessible food for remaining meals

STARTING RIGHT. NOW

The mission of Starting Right, Now is to end homelessness for youth by providing one-on-one mentoring, a stable home, assisting with employment opportunities, teaching financial literacy/life skills and promoting educational achievement.

- The TUF Life Skills Digital Curriculum shows measured improvement in students' Social and Emotional Learning, as well as improving school attendance, GPA, and overall behavior.

CAB'S IMPACT

- Clothing, beds, school supplies, tuition, car seats, uniforms, cribs, specialized tutoring, driver's license fees, SAT prep courses, music classes, infant formula, and more was purchased through the Children's Needs Funds which CAB sponsors.
- Food, medication, and veterinarian services for Tibet, the Courthouse Facility Dog that accompanies traumatized children in court while testifying; giving them courage to tell their horrific stories

VOICES FOR CHILDREN

The mission of Voices for Children is to provide support and advocacy for the abused, neglected, and abandoned children in our community. They partner with the Guardian ad Litem Program of Hillsborough County to ensure these children have a safe, loving and permanent home.

PROJECT STARFISH *COMPLETED!*

TAMPA, FLORIDA

Project Starfish's mission is to provide general health care services, diabetic screening, and treatment clinics serving children in Southern India, with American and Indian health care professionals collaborating to sustain medical coverage in these communities.

- Children Across Borders saw
 Project Starfish's mission from
 start to finish. With CAB
 donations, Project Starfish was
 able to purchase 2 ventilator
 machines (CPAP) for their neonatal
 intensive care unit (NICU)
- 103 neonates benefited from the ventilator machine which kept them alive
- 100% survival rate of neonates having used the equipment
