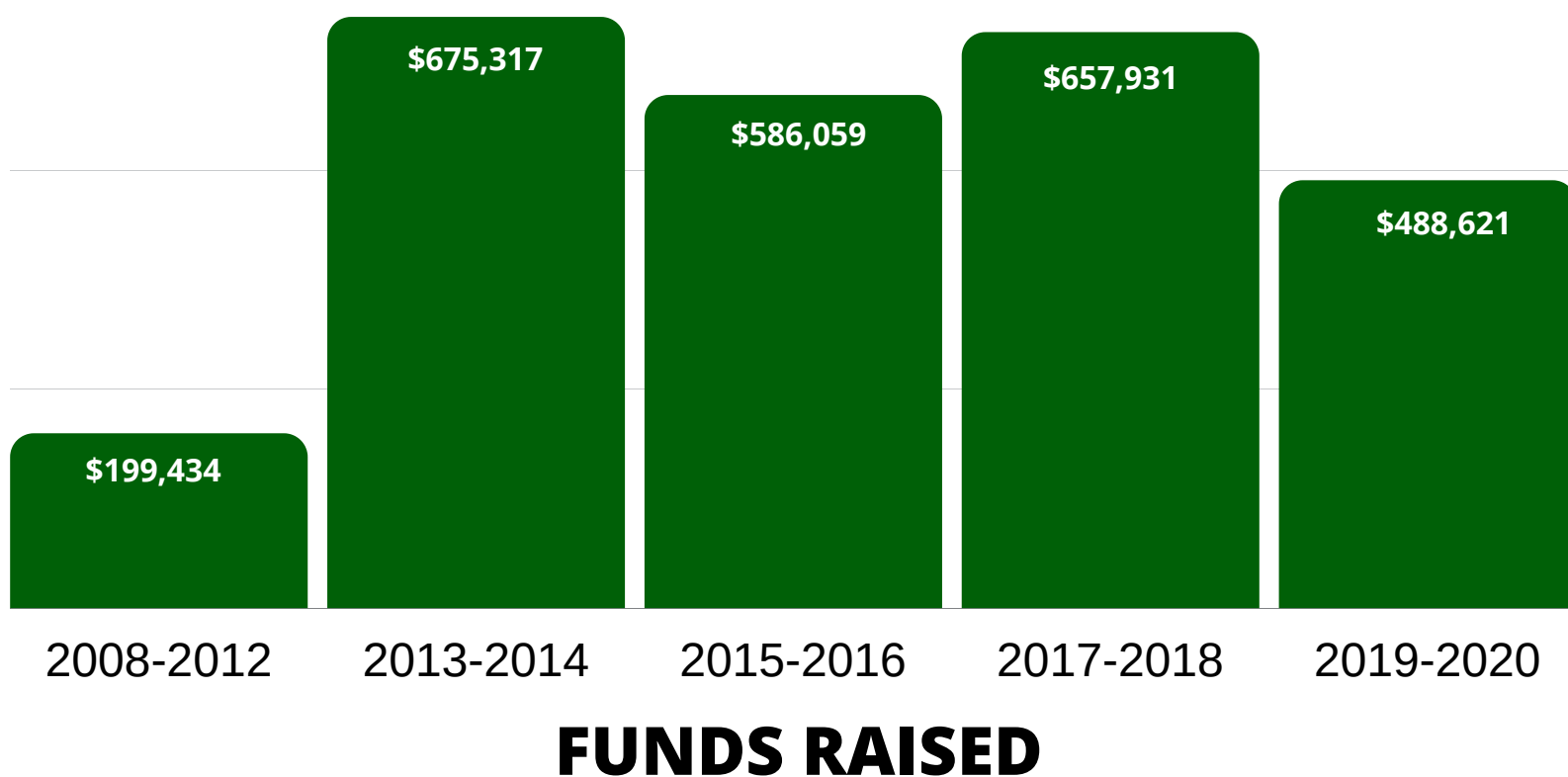
OUR NUMBERS

TUTORING**

The 1Voice Foundation offers a tutoring program to 47 pediatric cancer patients and their siblings. They provide dinner, one on one tutoring and group studies from pre-school age children to SAT and ACT test preparation. They have seen proven measurable outcomes with an increase in academic performance, better grades and Honor Roll awards via this program.

**G.R.I.P.
ADOLESCENT AND
YOUNG ADULT CAMP**

The 1Voice Foundation partners with fellow non-profits, Faces of Courage, Connective Human, B.A.S.E. Camp and the Rotarians, to provide 60 young adult campers who are currently on treatment or are cancer survivors seeking resources, guidance, peer support and life skills. Camp activities include boating, fishing, crafts, a talent show, dance, drum circle and time to bond with mentors.

**EQUINE THERAPY
AQUANTUM LEAP
FARM**

The 1Voice Foundation partnered with Quantum Leap Farm, to offer equine therapy to their patients and siblings. Patients receive physical, occupational and speech therapy using horses to strengthen core, balance, focus and processing. There are 35 participants enrolled in Equine Therapy.

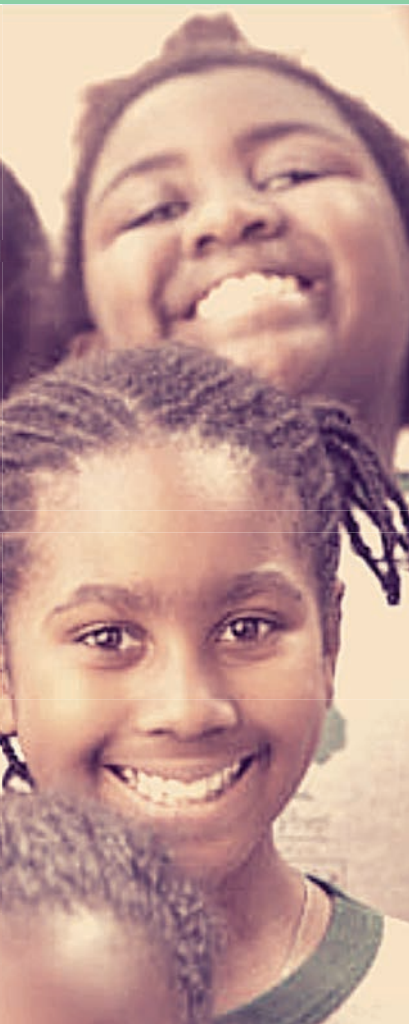

165 children participate in the 11th Month Program funded by CAB, allowing low-income students to have a valuable summer experience that may otherwise not be available to them. This includes providing educational and life skills training.

92% of students reported that they were ready to return to school for the fall semester, 71% of returning students retained/increased academic ability based on school year and 84% of the students reported learning something new from summer activities.

50 hours of academic classwork time was gained by students in the 11th Month Program.

Students were active and productive during the summer months with 14 afternoon enrichments offered including physical fitness, swimming, STEM, leadership institute, art, bowling, chess, Zumba, flag football, poetry, African dance, math capers and team makers, drama and basketball.

BROOKLYN EMERGING LEADERS ACADEMY

SPECIAL UPDATE

Initially, BELA intended to utilize CAB's grant to provide scholarships to students studying abroad for summer 2020. However, COVID-19 related travel bans resulted in the cancellation of all study abroad trips. BELA was given permission to redistribute the funds to support COVID-19 related expenses as well as upcoming international travel for BELA experiences.

CAB'S IMPACT

StudyAbroad Scholarship (Summer 2019): Student OW participated in a Language and Culture program in Seville, Spain and earned 3 college credits.

Zoom Account: In response to COVID-19 state-wide mandates, BELA transitioned to virtual learning and purchased Zoom to ensure students received live instruction, daily, and students with Individualized Education Plans continued to receive their mandated services.

Ghana Senior Trip: In February 2020, BELA took its inaugural graduating class on an international senior trip to Ghana. The trip served as their culminating learning experience within our school's Ethnic Studies framework and their International Baccalaureate classes. For the majority of students (> 90%) this was their first time traveling outside of the United States. With the funding from CAB, BELA offered scholarships to 9 students, who were in need of financial assistance to attend the trip.

30 children were nurtured, taught, and fed nutritious meals

55 students from lesser economic backgrounds facing language obstacles were taught and given remediation in their school subjects, taught to read and write the English alphabet, identify and draw shapes, and improved their physical and mental Health.

All migrant children and families belonging to Colvale were given food, water and care during the Covid-19 pandemic.

90% of the girls became regularly punctual

13 girls have improved their speaking and communication skill in English

29 girls are regularly washing their hands and learning good hygiene practices

MISSION

The mission of The Hemophilia Society, a registered organization affiliated with the Hemophilia Federation of India, is to provide educational and medical aid to those who have Hemophilia and are completing their education.

CAB'S IMPACT

20 students with Hemophilia were able to receive schooling, books, supplies, backpacks, shoes, and uniforms thanks to CAB funding.

With CAB donations, students receive healthcare for managing bleeding episodes which enable them to attend school regularly and subsequently excel at school exams. Physiotherapy and hydrotherapy treatments are attended to regularly.

80-100 children receive basic medical aid, such as bandages, braces, ankle binders, walkers, crutches, and more.

Students are trained in skills such as computer software, driving, farming, and entrepreneurship.

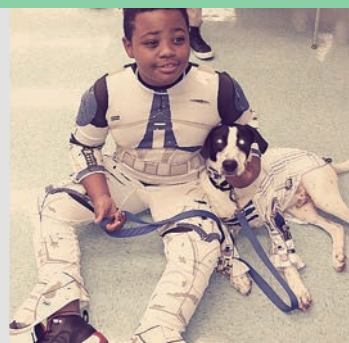

CAB's support improved the lives of the 1013 children in the Kids & Canines programs over the past year. Students consistently exhibit improvements socially, emotionally and academically, giving them a better chance to succeed in life. Specifically, CAB's funds impacted:

- Dorothy Thomas Center Teen Program for 5 classes / 40 teens
- Webb Middle School Teen Program for one class / 14 ESE students
- Benito Middle School Teen Program for one class / 10 ESE students
- Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) Teen Programs / 116 teens

(Note: DJJ services are at Tampa Residential Facility a 100 boys high-security facility, Columbus a 60 boys high-security facility and HGA a 20 girls maximum-security facility).

- Furry Tales for three elementary schools / 36 children
- Reading with Patriot offered to more than 764 children
- Vet care and professional care for program dogs, dog food, training supplies, adoption fees and other dog care and volunteer training and recruitment costs.

MATHRUSHREE SCHOOL FOR THE MENTALLY CHALLENGED

The mission of Mathrushree is to provide abandoned children and youth with intellectual disabilities with safe residence, proper education, and medical care.

CAB funded the iReady Program for math and reading intervention for the 2019-2020 school year at Pepin Academies. iReady supports data driven differentiated instruction for students in grades K-12. It is aligned with the Florida State Standards and it combines an adaptive diagnostic with individualized instruction. In addition, it provides reliable and valid growth measures. Through iReady, all our 800+ students in 3rd-12th grades at our Hillsborough campuses benefitted from this program.



Pepin Academies obtained the following performance indicators: 42% was the mean percentage in reading and 50% in mathematics.

The focus is to increase the number of students who reach their typical grow goal to 60% schoolwide. We have seen the results reflected in our data, student performance in the classroom, and the pride that our students have in their own success.

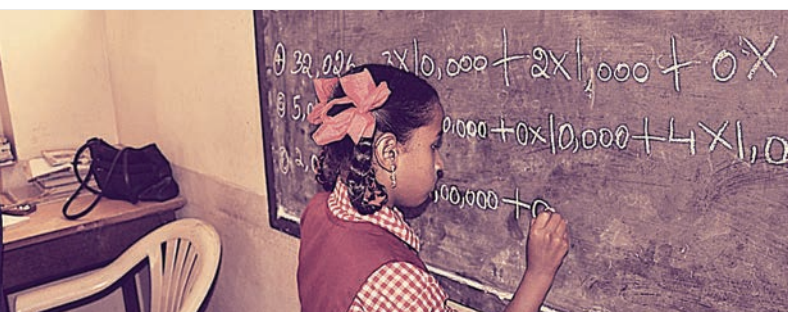

CAB funds enabled SRN to provide 50 students at both Haven Poe and Haven South with five hot meals per week, as well as stock their kitchens with food to prepare for breakfast, lunches and snacks. SRN is grateful our students were able to have access to nutritious food, because before joining our program, if they acquired money for food, they usually purchased cheap junk food.



Before entering our housing facility, these youths were in crisis mode, unable to focus on anything beyond surviving. With food and basic needs met, 100% of our 2019-2020 students were able to fully participate in our programming and reach their next life goal. Our 2019 students were able to graduate high school on time, receive acceptance to post-secondary educational goals, obtain scholarships/financial aid, secure funds in a bank account, actively heal from past traumas and demonstrate improved mental/emotional/physical health. Our underclassmen are currently on the same path.
